The purpose of the parade is to celebrate our freedoms and to remember our men and women serving our country to ensure those freedoms. By participating in the parade you will be promoting your organization, community and national pride.

APPLICATION DEADLINE JUNE 27, 2020

Start Time and Route: All parade participants will assemble on Riverside Drive at Spring Street at 9AM for staging. The parade will begin PROMPTLY at 10:00AM and will travel north on Spring Street to Eighth Street. **Since we will not be holding a ceremony in Warder Park you will be free to leave the area as soon as you turn right onto Eighth Street from Spring Street.**

Parade Rules:

All entries MUST have an approved application in order to participate. This includes walking entries as well as motorized entries.

Parade entries may include, but are not limited to, floats, bands, military vehicles, groups, walkers, etc. No horses or large animals are permitted in the parade. All entries must provide their own parade vehicle and have patriotic theme/decorations.

If your vehicle is carrying a Member of the Military you will be at the beginning of the parade. Please report to Jim Ford at the corner of Market and Spring for specific directions.

Current elected officials and candidates for elected office will provide and ride in their own vehicle. Placement for these will throughout the parade behind all military participants.

Any late entry will be placed at the end of the parade by a Parade Marshall.

In the event a unit breaks down, the unit MUST pull over and allow all others to pass.

Due to the restrictions from COVID-19 pandemic no items will be passed out along the parade route. This includes flyers, papers, candy or any other items.

The Committee will follow all Federal, State or Local guidelines for the COVID-19 pandemic and safe gathering. If there is a determination that we should not hold the Parade you will be notified immediately.
