Chili & Brew Bonanza 2020 Rules

Thanks for being a participant in Jeffersonville Main Street Inc.'s 14th annual Chili & Brew Bonanza. This is a fun event and silent auction fundraiser for Jeffersonville Main Street Inc. It will be held **Tuesday, March 3, 2020**. The event is from 5:30 pm-8:30 pm at the Sheraton Hotel. 700 W. Riverside Drive, Jeffersonville, IN 47130.

Listed below are rules for the chili makers:

1. You will be provided with a table, tablecloth, bowls, spoons, napkins, chafing dish, and sterno fuel.
2. **Please bring your chili to the event WARM** because the chafing dishes will not have enough heat in them to warm up cold chili before the event begins.
3. Bring enough chili for **250 tastings**. You will be giving out 2oz. tastings of your chili – so you will need 3 to 4 gallons of chili.
4. Doors open for set up at 2:00 pm. **Set up must be completed by 4:30 pm.**
5. **Judging will begin at 4:45 pm.** The event opens to the public at 5:30 pm.
6. Please make sure you have someone to work your table at all times. Event runs 5:30 pm-8:30 pm.
7. **Access to electric outlets is very limited - so we do not encourage using it at your table.** (If you must have electric then you will need to contact us and also plan to bring an extension cord and power strip.)
8. Each chili maker gets get two free admissions to the event (yourself +1).
9. Bring a small sign or banner for your table/area that identifies your organization. We encourage you to decorate your area. **You will have ½ of a table.**
10. Prizes will be awarded in Professional & Novice Divisions (3 in each) and One People's Choice. Judges decisions are final.
